ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Lincoln Veterans Memorial Coalition Inc. as requested by Supervisor Weygandt.

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the placement of a Veterans' Memorial in McBean Park on November 11, 2019 by the Lincoln Veterans Coalition Inc. All veterans who lived in Placer County are eligible to be honored on the memorial so that they may be remembered as brave service men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice for their families and their country. Funding for the memorial will come from a variety of sources including donations from individuals, corporations and foundations, grants, and the sale of veteran plaques to be placed on the memorial. The requested Revenue Share funds will be used to defray the cost of the memorial.
