Roadway Safety Sign Upgrade Project

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Purchasing Manager, or designee, to award and execute an agreement with Salaber Associates Inc. for Construction Management, Construction Inspection, and Materials Testing Related Services for the Roadway Safety Sign Upgrade Project for an amount of \$212,480 upon County Counsel and Risk Management concurrence; and to execute future amendments to the agreement up to ten percent (10%) as needed. The project funded by a combination of Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program Funds (90%) and local Road Funds (10%).

BACKGROUND

The Roadway Safety Sign Upgrade Project provides a systemic solution for collision locations, mainly in the curve of roadways, in the form of updating curve warning signage for the whole length of the selected roadways. Current Caltrans standards as identified in the 2014 Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) specify placement of new warning signs for roadway curves based upon the advisory speed of the curve, as well as replacement of signs due to deteriorating physical condition or lack of reflectivity of the sign.

On April 24, 2017, your Board approved the award of a qualified list of firms for Construction Management, Construction Inspection, Materials Testing and Construction Surveying Services as a result of a competitive Request for Qualifications No. 10327. These firms provide services as needed for specific projects for agreement amounts up to \$300,000. The Department of Public Works (DPW) solicited informal proposals from several firms off of this qualified list of firms to provide Construction Management, Construction Inspection and Materials Testing Services needed for this project. One firm responded and submitted a proposal which was evaluated by a panel comprised of DPW staff. After reviewing the proposal, the evaluation panel determined that Salaber Associates Inc. of Dixon, CA, was qualified and responsive. The agreement with Salaber Associates, Inc. is necessary to manage all construction related activities.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The Professional Services Agreement is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15306. A Notice of Exemption was prepared, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) with State Clearing House No. 2017058233 on May 11, 2017. A Categorical Exclusion Determination was approved by Caltrans on June 2, 2017, in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of the construction services agreement is \$212,480 and is budgeted in the Department of Public Works and Facilities FY 2018-19 Final Budget, Engineering Division, under project PJ00519. Funding is provided by a combination of Federal Highway Safety Improvement Funds (90%) and local Road Funds (10%).


Resolution Location Map
