ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$300 in Revenue Sharing monies to Placer County Museums as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$100) and Supervisor Holmes (\$200).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve an appropriation to help support the Placer County Museums Docent Guild for their 12th annual Heritage Trail Museums Tour. The Heritage Trail Museums Tour is an annual event that offers free admission and special activities one day a week at museums in Placer County from Lincoln to Lake Tahoe all summer long. The Placer County Museums Docent Guild consists of docents and volunteers who help to promote Placer County's unique history by working to highlight and preserve the county's 24 museums. Last year, more than 4,800 people from all over the region visited participating museums to learn about the rich and varied history of this area. The funds received with this Revenue Sharing request will be used to promote the Heritage Trail Museums Tour event and encourage the community to come out and visit Placer County museums.
